The diamond-themed gala celebrated The Arc of Palm Beach County's 60th anniversary. Friends and supporters of the nonprofit enjoyed a lavish evening of gourmet dining, swinging music, and a cowboy casino.

The packed ballroom erupted in hoots and hollers as honorary chairs Bobby and Barbara Campbell announced a \$250,000 pledge. Calling The Arc his favorite charity, Bobby Campbell said the gift would be his first donation toward expanding The Arc's center on the Florida Atlantic University Research Park campus.
