Anyone who has ever been to a show at the West Palm Beach venue at 701 Okeechobee Blvd. knows that being

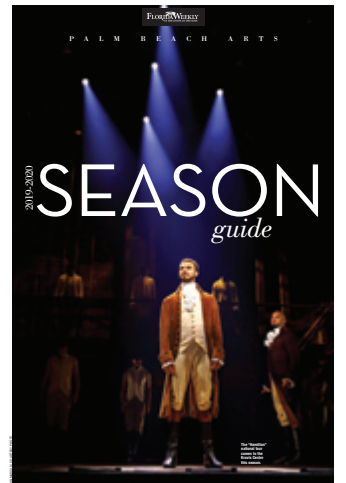

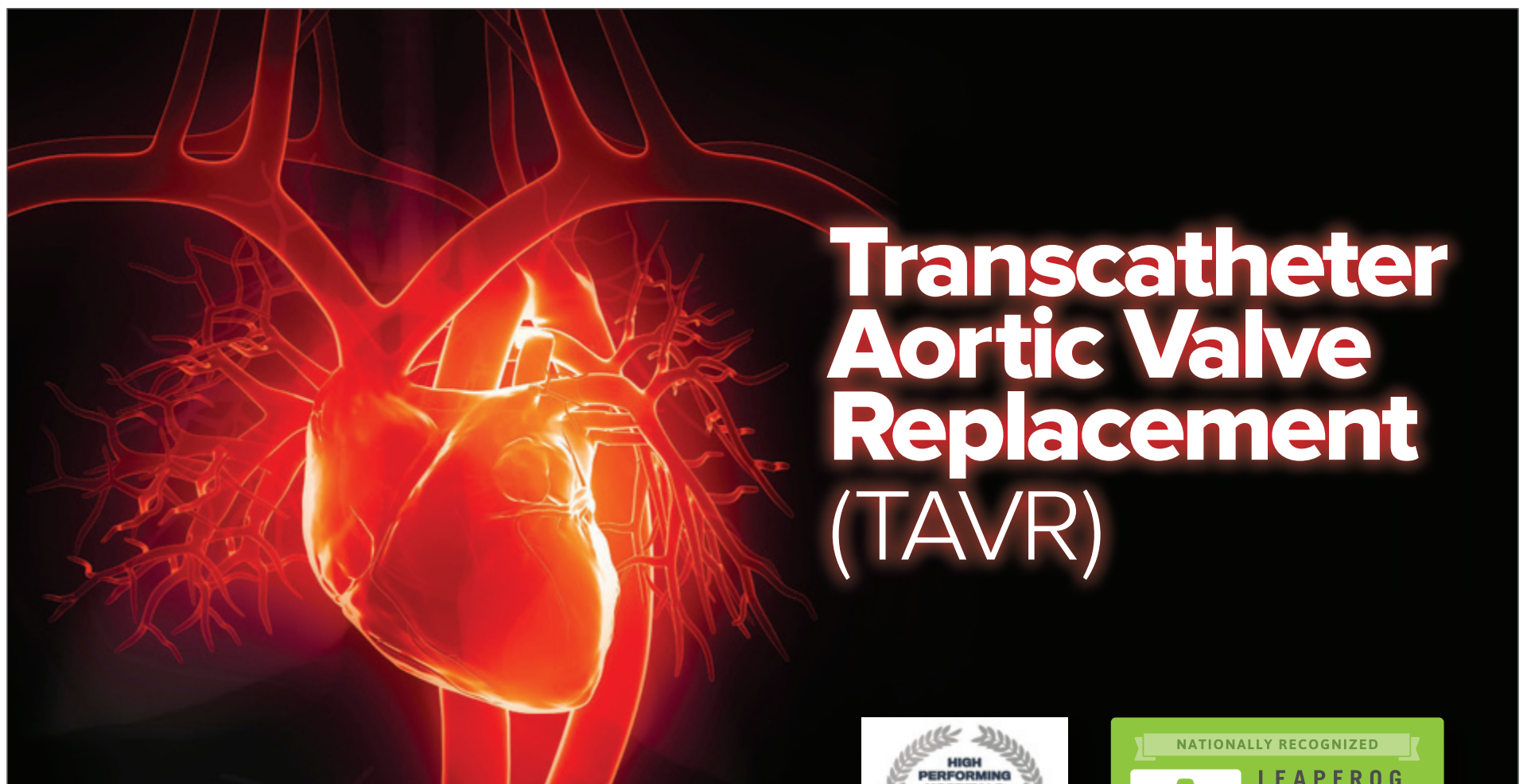
